A half hour's drive from George Town through a narrow jungle road leads you to this little known retreat. A Balinese-style little resort, far away from the bustle of the city and with minimal mobile network connection.

s you might guess from the name. you'll be staying on Love Lane, one of the most historic and charming addresses right in the heart of Unesco World Heritage Site George Town. The award-winning 23LoveLane is a charming spot set in a walled garden with an entrance much like the setting for an old Shanghai film. Amidst tranquil landscaped gardens, the hotel consists of four buildings - the Anglo-Indian Bungalow (the first floor





houses a library!), Straits Eclectic Building, 1920s Jack Roof Annex and Indian Shop House - all of which were carefully restored following strict guidelines.

After you check in, place your phone in its docking station, and then unpack your luggage into the vintage wooden cabinet. A tasteful mix of the old and new (and yes, wifi is available), 23LoveLane is a gorgeous hotel that is definitely worth the slightly upscale price. Centrally located, there's a huge variety of good food and cafés in the area. However, one should know that



George Town \* 1881 Chong Tian Cultural

(Heritage) Hotel 38, 40, 42, Jalan Pintal Tali, George Town (+604 263 1881/ www.1881chongtian.com). This hotel has enjoyed, and is still, enjoying, success since the 1800s when it catered to prominent merchants who came to Penang to trade and has since achieved cultural heritage status. With its spacious and comfortable rooms, you are sure to enjoy your time in this 130-odd-year-old building. Guests are transported back in time to relive the wealth and class of Chinese high society of old with the luxurious decorations made up of traditional Chinese furniture from the owners' own collection. In lieu with its heritage preservation efforts, there is also an onsite museum that stores antiques from various dynasties of China.

Rooms are located around two
